**FT. MEADE TOUR AND THE HOLOCAUST MUSEUM
THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2016**

Begin the day with a guided bus tour of Fort George G. Meade, an Army installation that includes the Defense Information School, the United States Army Field Band, and the headquarters of the United States Cyber Command and National Security Agency. Originally opened in 1917, Ft. Meade has a rich history serving as a recruit training post and prisoner of war camp during World War II. Following the bus tour, enjoy lunch at one of Ft. Meade's dining facilities. After lunch, visit The Holocaust Museum, America's only national memorial to the Holocaust. Established by a unanimous Act of Congress, the museum contains a permanent exhibit of artifacts, films, photographs, and oral histories that document the Nazi genocide. The narrative begins with images of death and destruction as witnessed by American soldiers during the liberation of Nazi concentration camps in 1945, **something the Timberwolves experienced first-hand. The Hall of Remembrance serves as a place of reflection.

Memorial Tour

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2016

See our nation's War Memorials during a driving tour of Washington, D.C. Stop at the Lincoln Memorial and visit the Korean War and Vietnam War Memorials. Enjoy a maritime movie at the U.S. Navy Memorial and Naval Heritage Center, built to honor the sailors of the U.S. Navy. Afterward, stop at the Ronald Reagan Building and International Trade Center, which is the largest building (3.1 million square feet) in Washington, DC and is the first and only federal building dedicated to both government and private use. While there, enjoy lunch on your own at the Reagan Building food court - named one of the "best family food courts" in DC. After lunch, free time will be allowed at the World War II Memorial, the first national memorial dedicated to all who served during World War II.
