TOURS

Thursday, 9:30 am–2:30 pm — *We will board the bus 9:30 am and head to the Warbirds museum, then at 11 am we will board the bus and head for the Museum of Military History with a stop for lunch on your own along the way. We will be back at the hotel by 2:30. Each museum will take approximately 1.5 hours to visit. The cost of this tour is included with your registration and it includes the bus, escort and admission to both museums.*

The Kissimmee Air Museum Home of the Warbirds is a unique collection of aircraft, memorabilia and projects in various stages of restoration. Experience aviation first hand with the planes, pilots, and projects. Enjoy the living history and take pictures of the constantly changing exhibits. The aircraft are not hidden behind ropes but are available for close up inspection as they are keeping the excitement alive for the pilots of tomorrow. Just please don't feed the mechanics.
