NATIONAL WORLD WAR II MUSEUM

Thursday, August 22

Dedicated in 2000 as the National D-Day Museum and now designated by Congress as the country's official WWII Museum, this remarkable attraction illuminates the American experience during the WWII era. From the Normandy invasion to the sands of the Pacific Islands and the Home Front, you will see the courage, teamwork and sacrifice of the men and women who won *the war that changed the world*. Explore moving personal stories and powerful interactive displays. New in 2013, visit the US Freedom Pavilion: The Boeing Center, which tells the story of our nation's unprecedented industrial capability during the war years. For an additional cost view the powerfully authentic 4-D cinematic experience, *Beyond All Boundaries*, narrated and executively produced by Tom Hanks, in the Solomon Victory Theater. Visit the Soda Shop or Chef John Besh's The American Sector Restaurant for lunch on your own. WWII Vets do not have to pay the Museum admission price – see Vet's price below.
